

# Resurrection Rolls

## Ingredients

- 1 (10 ounce) can refrigerated crescent dinner rolls
- 8 large marshmallows
- 1/4 cup melted butter
- 2 tablespoons ground cinnamon
- 2 tablespoons white sugar

## **Directions**

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.
2. Lightly grease a baking sheet.
3. In a small bowl, mix together cinnamon and sugar.
4. While you are waiting for the oven to preheat read John 19.
5. As you put the rolls together explain the meaning of each element,.
6. Unroll the crescent rolls (which represents the burial cloths of Jesus).
7. Roll the white marshmallow (which represents the pure sinless body of Jesus) in butter and cinnamon sugar (which represents the burial oils and spices)
8. Wrap the cinnamon sugar covered marshmallow in the crescent roll tightly. You don't want the marshmallow to seep out while baking.
9. Place the rolls in the oven (which represents the tomb).
10. Bake as instructed on the package.
11. While baking, read John 20:1-18 about the empty tomb and, if you've never made these before, see if your kids can predict what will happen to the marshmallow.
12. One the rolls are cooled, open to reveal the missing marshmallow. Jesus has risen! He is ALIVE!
