CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your home or small group:

DEVOTIONS

Use this simple liturgy when you light a candle as the "Christ candle" for Christmas. It may also be a candle in the center of your Advent wreath.

Leader: John 1:5 reads, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it." Jesus is the true light who gives light to every person. As we light this candle we celebrate the birth of Jesus, the true light of the world.

All: Thank you, Lord Jesus, for being born into our world. Light our hearts, our homes, and our world for you, our Savior.

Christmas festivities usually involve a great deal of preparation and cleaning up. Resolve to work together to carry out the necessary chores. If you are guests at another home, do what you can to serve your hosts this Christmas with willing hands.
